70 SUNREEF POWER

Launched in the last weeks of 2015, the 70 Sunreef Power *Violetta* is a comfortable cruiser with a futuristic look. Her layout and design both were entirely customized and adapted to her Owner's expectations of having a bespoke residence on the water.

One of *Violetta's* most characteristic features is the enclosed flybridge - a solution introduced to the 70 Sunreef Power range with the launch of the 70 Power *Ondin*. *Violetta's* protected sundeck provides for a navigation station fitted with large helm seats with integrated autopilot controls.

The area also features a gym, a relaxation space with a sofa that can be turned into an additional bed, a fridge, sink and TV. Accessed through a sliding door is the aft terrace housing a jet-ski crane and sun mattresses.

The 70 Sunreef Power *Violetta* features a powerful 1200 Volvo IPS system and a dynamic positioning. Other than high performance, the IPS propulsion previously installed on the 60 Sunreef Power *Lilu* and 70 Sunreef Power *1 Life* allows a significant increase of maneuverability and ease of mooring.

Violetta is equipped with wave-piercers and extended aft platforms to maximise her performance and provide a comfortable motion at sea.
