SUNREEF'S 68 IS SUPREME

THE CAT THAT GOT THE CREAM

Created to respond to a growing demand for more personalized, comfortable and technically advanced units that embody the very specific philosophy of yacht creation, the Sunreef Supreme 68 Eagle Wings is the first launch within the Polish yard's new Supreme Range. Debuting at the Singapore Yacht Show in April it understandably attracted a lot of attention. As the first sailing catamaran under 78' (24m) to boast a total living space equaling 3,330sqft (300sqm) it offers the kind of comfort one would usually associate with a superyacht. In order to achieve this the designers situated the salon and exterior deck at the same level, resulting in an enormous main salon surrounded with floor to ceiling glass and a seamless transition into the cockpit. Direct access to the deck is achieved through sliding doors on both sides of the yacht. Hence, the exterior and interior surfaces of the boat merge into one panoramic lounging and dining area.

Elsewhere the layout comprises of two well-appointed guest cabins with generous en-suites featuring stone tile finishing, plus two voluminous master suites. The portside staircase features a custom-made stair lift, the first we

remember seeing on a yacht, which facilitates cabin access for one of the Owner's older family members. The crew quarters on Eagle Wings accommodates three people in the aft portside cabin and one in the yacht's forepeak. One of our favorite features of Eagle Wings is the immense 700sqft (65sqm) flybridge that is topped with an elegant bimini. A further entertainment space on the foredeck incorporates large sun pads or to enjoy a bath in the Jacuzzi. As on all of Sunreef's 68' models, Eagle Wings is equipped with an aft garage that conveniently houses her 16' 6" (5m) tender, two jetskis, diving gear and sails. The garage door, when lowered, levels with the yacht's aft platforms to create an exterior lounging and sunbathing space. The boat's mast is fixed at flybridge level with a carbon–made transversal archshaped beam–yet another innovative system from Sunreef and one that is designed to keep the saloon's surface entirely open. Continuing to push the envelop in the catamaran sector Sunreef has another brand new model, this time a motor cat, scheduled for launch this summer.
