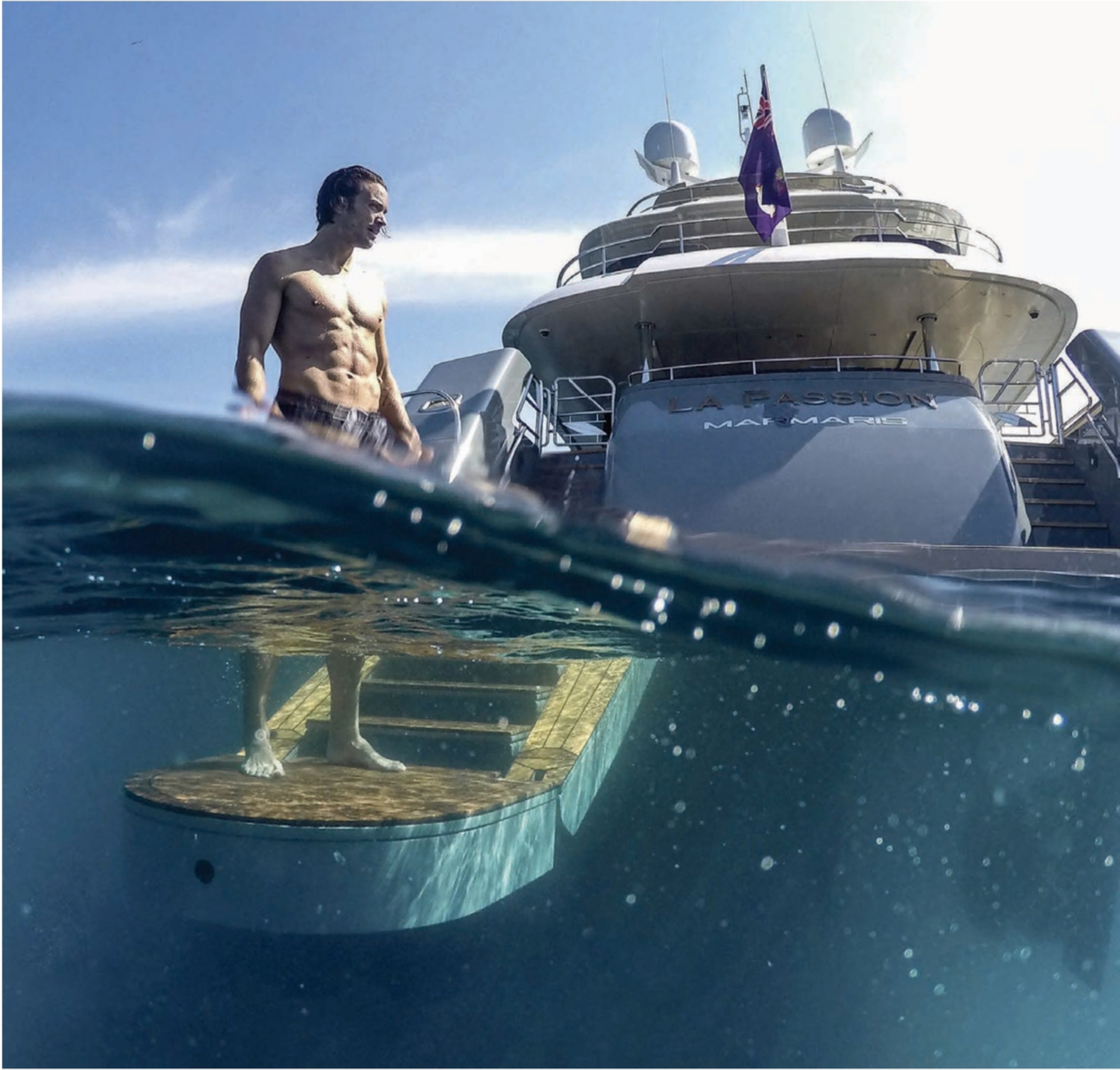

SUNREEF'S SUPREME 68' MODEL DEBUTS IN SINGAPORE

Premiered at the Singapore Yacht Show in April, the Sunreef Supreme 68 model brought a breath of fresh air in the catamaran world. The launch of the first yacht within the range—the Singapore-based Eagle Wings—represented the first time a luxury sailing catamaran of just 68' (21m) in length has provided a total living space equaling over 3,000sqft (300sqm), the kind of real estate one would usually associate with a superyacht. In August the Polish shipyard launched their second hull in the series, christened Midori (Japanese for green) this stately sailing 68-footer personifies the Owner's desire to create a harmoniously conceived yacht reflecting the tranquility and moderation of the Japanese aesthetics and philosophy. Midori's original style combines well with the Sunreef Supreme's innovative design, featuring a superstructure made to maximize onboard space with a vast saloon opening onto the cockpit.

The yacht owes her soothing atmosphere largely to Bram Van Scharen, who was appointed by the Owner as interior designer and worked with Sunreef Yachts' in-house design team to develop Midori's signature décor. An adviser for high-end private residential projects as well as superyacht interior design work, he produced a timeless and discrete style to give Midori a unique touch. Midori's vast saloon is surrounded with full-height windows spans over 700sqft (65sqm) of intelligently employed living surface. Its bow section features a large galley stretching the salon's entire width. The ample storage spaces and kitchen appli-

ances are discretely covered with black matte panels while the central countertop neighbors a large dining table with seating for eight.

A customized Devialet loudspeaker sets the audio soundscape, while Midori's floors and deck are entirely clad in teak to compliment the liners of soothing smoke blue. The cat will sleep eight guests in three comfortable cabins, plus the master suite, each given a distinct color scheme, varying from anthracite to aqua marine and eucalyptus. All of them feature clever storage, retractable TV's, Fosgate speakers and ample en-suites covered in sintered quartz and equipped with Vola accessories. The Owner's cabin benefits from a dressing area, a desk, a drop-down TV and a generous master bathroom.

Midori features an immense flybridge of 700sqft (65sqm) too, topped with an elegant bimini. This scenic area is fitted with a bar, a dining area, large sofa and sunpads. The yacht's foredeck terrace is the place to relax on large sun pads or to enjoy a bath in the Jacuzzi. The boat is equipped with an aft garage—featured on all the Sunreef Supreme 68's—where a 16' (5m) tender and up to two jet-skis, diving gear and sails can be stowed. The garage door, when lowered, levels with the yacht's aft platforms to create an expansive bathing platform—a solution introduced for the first time on a catamaran below 70'. Midori is rigged with a Hydranet Main Sail and Jib as well as a Code 0 and Parasail for an optimized sailing performance in all conditions. www.sunreef-yachts.com
