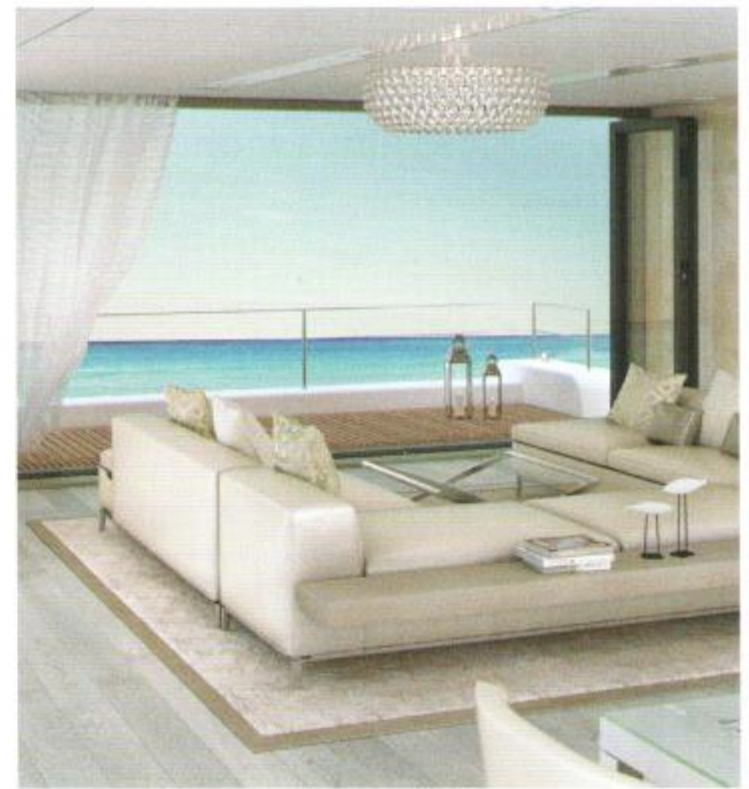
### SUNREEF SUPREME 68
