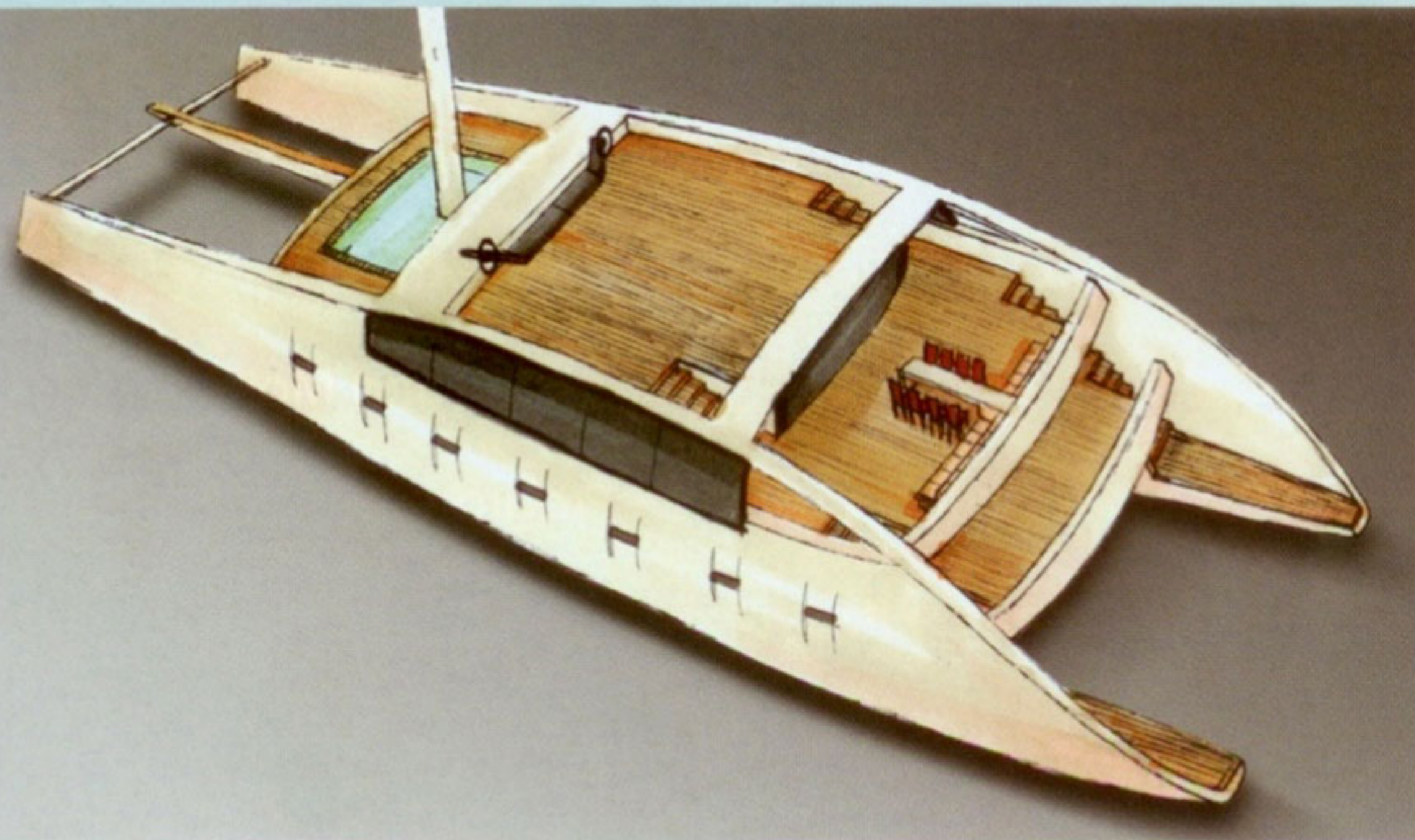
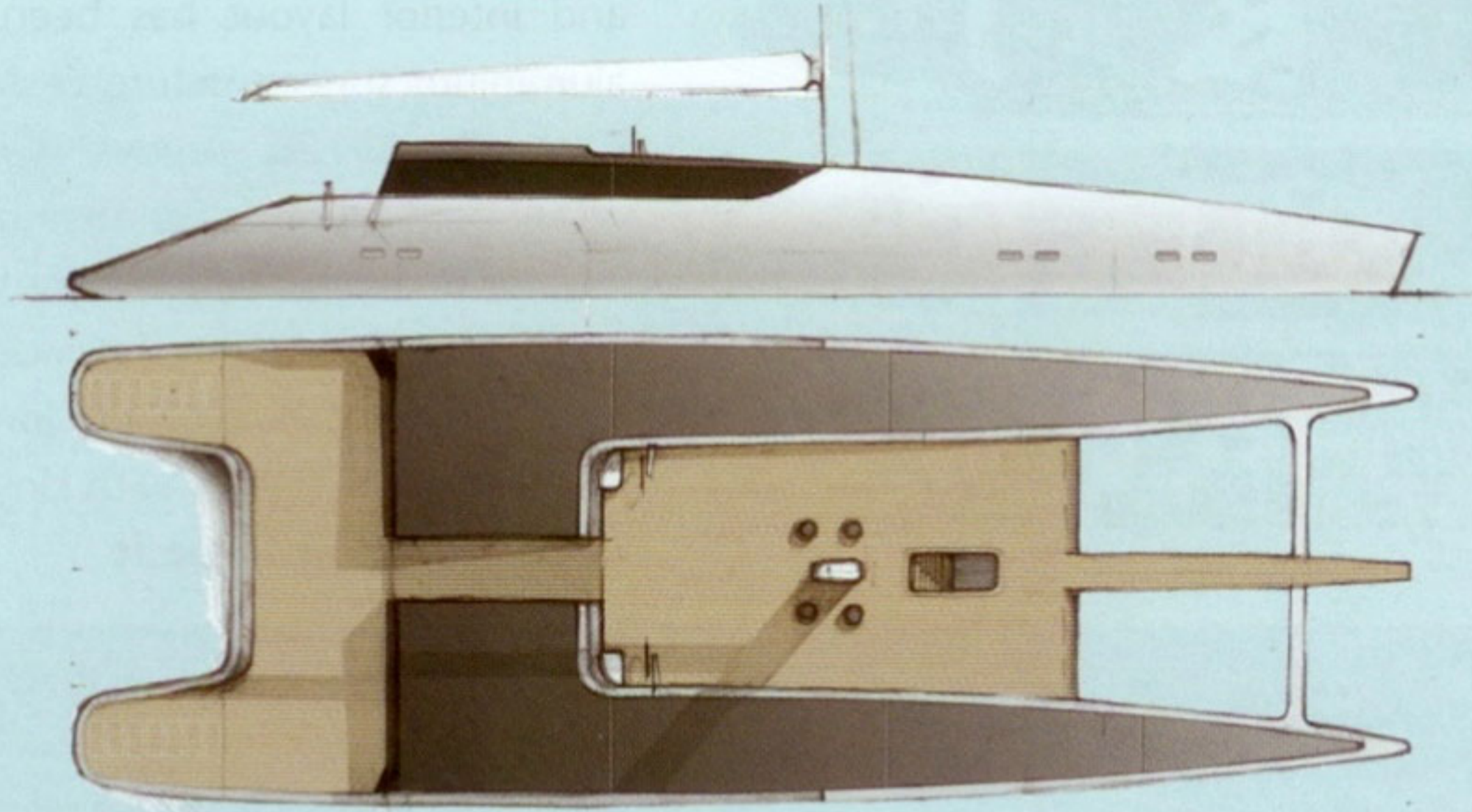


Grand Designs

The Polish builders of sailing catamarans, Sunreef Yachts, have recently released details on their three new projects of 150 ft (46.30 m), 170 ft (52.00 m) and 200 ft (61.00 m) respectively. As a fast growing company, which began back in 2002, these latest new designs represent their largest to date, and will – they claim – make them the largest builder of a luxury catamaran when any of these three designs are contracted, constructed and launched.



Sunreef's design team is still working on the exact details of the specifications, so full information – as of yet – is limited. However, the first release shows the large scale to which these catamarans will be built, with the 150 having a beam of 16 metres, mast clearance of 46.00 m and a sail area of 700 m². The 170 will have a beam of 18 metres, mast clearance of 50 metres and a sail area of 850 m²; and the 200 will have a beam of 21 metres, and a sail area of 1,000 m²!
